NORTHCREST HOA BOARD MEETING ZOOM Video Conferencing July 23, 2020

They have torn up Clubview, Clubridge, and the alley at Carol Good. They are tearing out the Clubview alley now, but the Embassy Way alley has been re-poured. There are some areas of concern that need to be addressed around the transformers. The City contacted the HOA and asked about the sidewalk in front of 2001 - 2011 Embassy Way. They have to tear out quite a bit of the concrete and cannot match the exposed aggregate. Marilyn made a motion to have the contractor replace it and the HOA pay for it so the concrete would all match. The motion was seconded by Gerry and it carried.

Audit has been set up and the taxes are done. John has a good number for 2033 CR so he is working on the inspection for the foundation. 2020 CR is being delayed because of requests from 2022 and 2018 to have their foundation looked at prior to working on 2020.

NEW BUSINESS

Marilyn asked that 2055 EW fence gets stained on the back panel.

No homeowners were present.
