Passes are available at the management office, 2815 Valley View Lane, Suite 101, Farmers Branch. This rule and our private pass code is to keep those outside of our neighborhood from using the pool. Also, follow social distancing rules. The pool will be closing after Columbus Day, October 13, 2020.

Thank you for your patience during these trying times of construction. We realize our property is not looking the best but the construction is out of our control. As work is completed by the city the board will do a walk through for any improvements needed. The city will not repair the sprinklers until paving is completed, which is probably closer to the end of the year.
